Day 3: Mandawa to Bikaner

Journey 190 kilometers in 4 hours to reach Bikaner, famously known as the "Camel Country" of Rajasthan. Upon arrival, immerse yourself in the grandeur of Junagarh Fort, marvel at Lalgarh Palace's architectural beauty, and wander through the bustling old city where traditional life continues unchanged for centuries.

Day 4: Bikaner Exploration

Dedicate this full day to Bikaner's unique attractions. Visit the fascinating Karni Mata Temple in Deshnok, known as the Rat Temple, where thousands of rats are considered sacred. Explore the National Research Centre on Camel, learning about these desert ships, and discover more royal palaces and heritage sites that define this desert city.

Journey to the Golden City

Day 5: Bikaner to Jaisalmer

Embark on the longest but most scenic drive of your journey – 330 kilometers over 6-7 hours to reach the legendary Golden City of Jaisalmer. The route takes you deeper into the Thar Desert, with an optional stop at the historic Pokhran Fort. Upon arrival, check into your hotel and enjoy a relaxing evening as you prepare for tomorrow's adventures.

Day 6: Jaisalmer to Jodhpur

Begin your morning exploring the magnificent Jaisalmer Fort and the intricate Patwon Ki Haveli, marveling at the golden sandstone architecture that gives the city its nickname. Then journey 280 kilometers over 5-6 hours to Jodhpur, the Blue City, where you'll check into your hotel and rest after the scenic desert drive.

The transition from golden Jaisalmer to blue Jodhpur showcases Rajasthan's incredible diversity, where each city has developed its own distinct character and color palette that reflects its unique history and culture.

Day 7: Jodhpur Sightseeing

Immerse yourself in Jodhpur's royal grandeur by visiting the imposing Mehrangarh Fort, one of India's largest forts, offering breathtaking views of the blue city below. Pay respects at the elegant Jaswant Thada memorial, explore the magnificent Umaid Bhawan Palace, and lose yourself in the narrow blue-painted lanes and vibrant clock tower market.



Day 8: Jodhpur to Udaipur

Journey 250 kilometers over 5-6 hours to reach Udaipur, with a magnificent stop at the Ranakpur Jain Temples, renowned for their intricate marble architecture and 1,444 uniquely carved pillars. Upon reaching the City of Lakes, check into your hotel and enjoy an optional evening boat ride on the romantic Lake Pichola.

The route from Jodhpur to Udaipur takes you through the Aravalli Hills, offering a dramatic change in landscape from desert plains to lake-dotted valleys, culminating in one of India's most romantic cities.

Day 9: Udaipur Sightseeing

Day 10: Udaipur to Pushkar

Visit the rare Brahma Temple, one of the few temples dedicated to Lord Brahma in the world, explore the holy Pushkar Lake with its numerous ghats, and wander through the colorful bazaars filled with spiritual artifacts and local handicrafts.

Day 12: Jaipur Sightseeing


